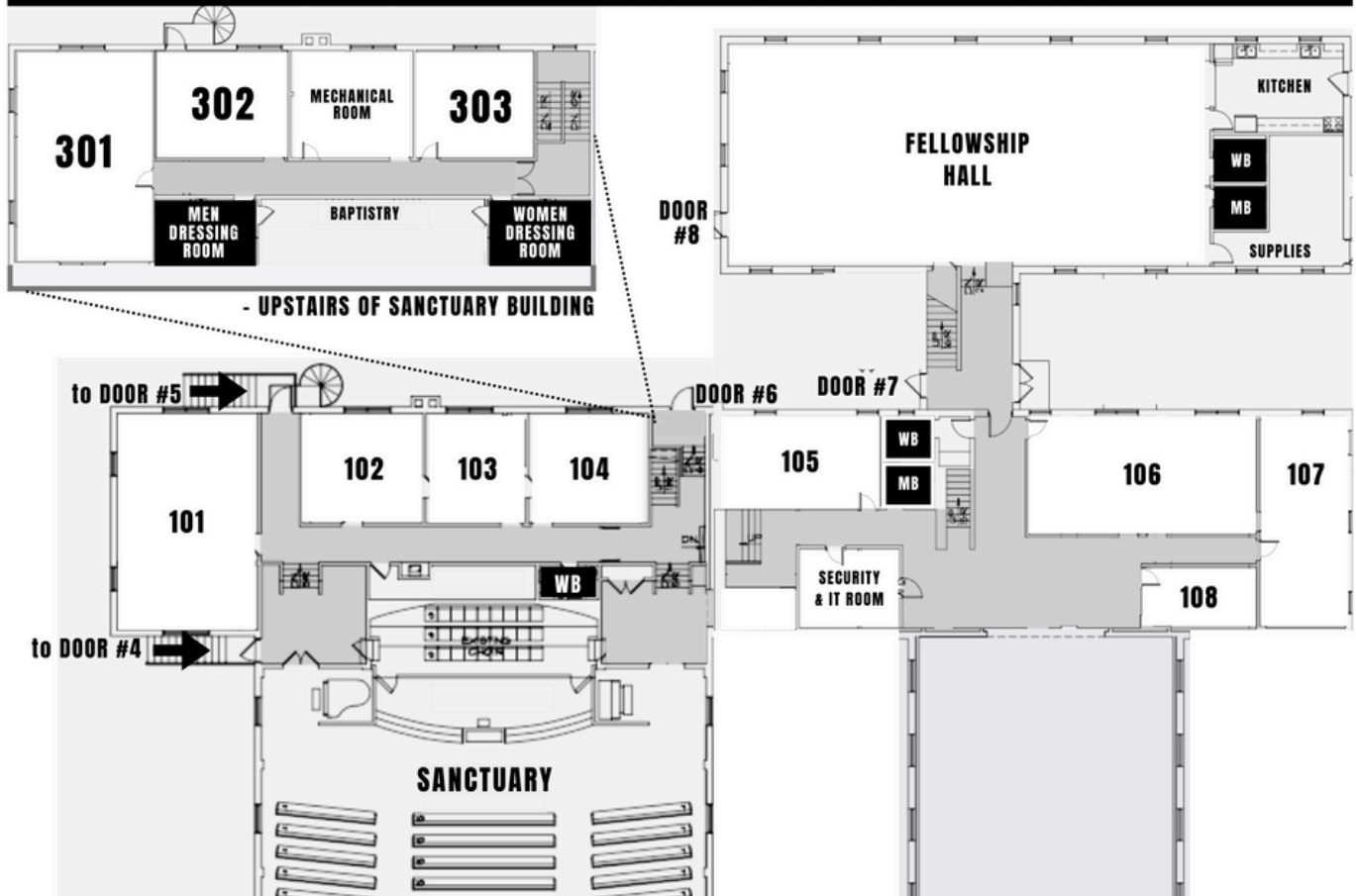
## **Pastor's Class • Adult CoEd • Michael Hodge & Doug Allen • Fellowship Hall**

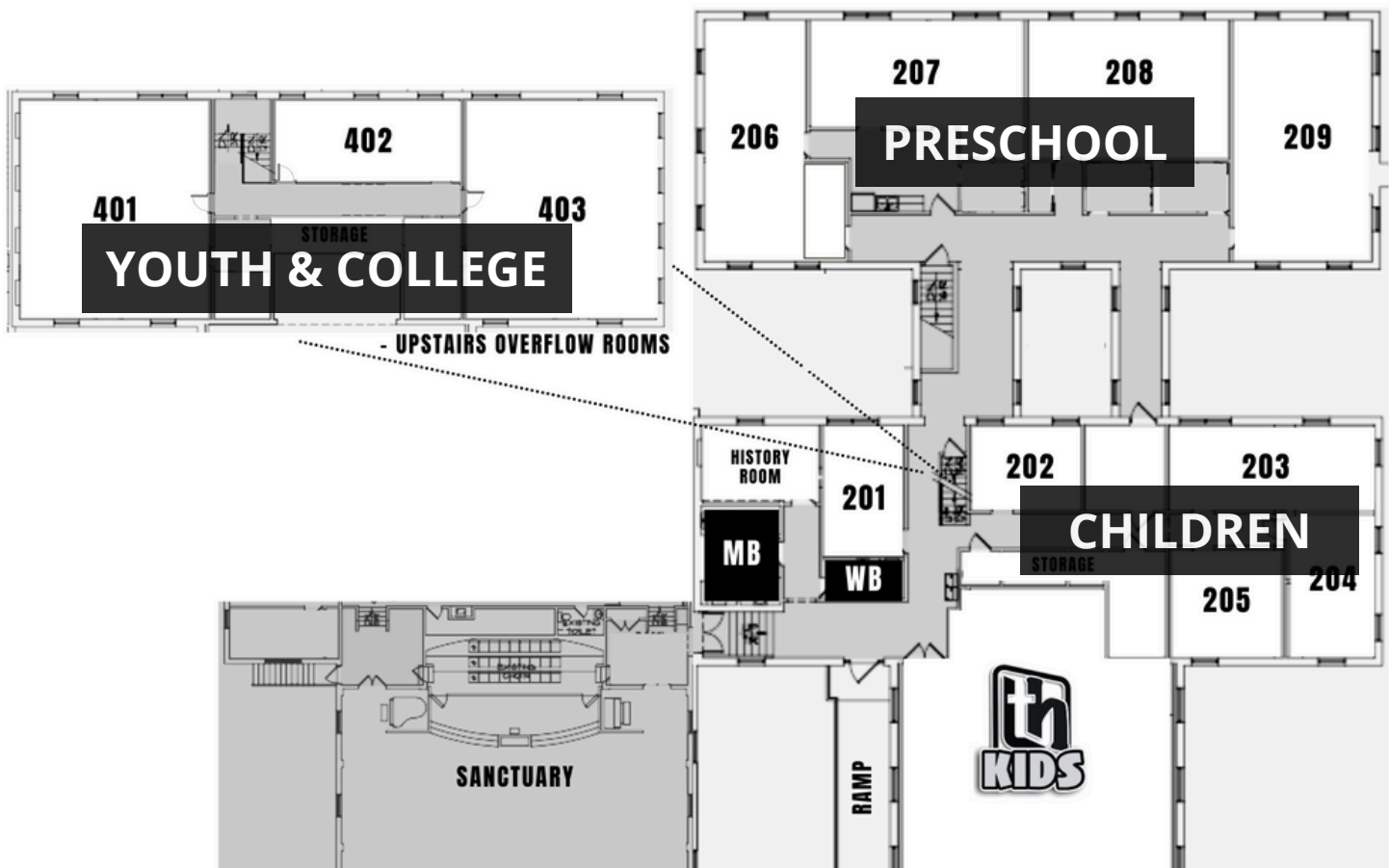


# CAMPUS MAP
