DRESS CODE:

FUGE asks that all students and adults to:

- Wear modest shorts. When hands and arms are extended, the fingertips must touch the end of the fabric.
- Sleeveless shirts, tank tops, spaghetti straps, open back, or excessive armpit cutouts are not allowed.
- Large t-shirts that cover the shorts are not allowed.
- Wear modest pants, jeans, and dresses for worship.
 Dresses with spaghetti, small straps, open backs, and short lengths are not acceptable at all.
- Do not dress in a way that draws attention to underwear. (*This includes sagging pants or rolling down waistbands*.)





WHAT TO PACK:

- Twin size linens, towels, pillows, blankets, or sleeping bag
- Water bottle to reuse and refill
- Closed-toed, closed-heel shoes
- Bible, notepad, and pen
- Toiletries such as toothpaste, toothbrush, and soap
- Sun protection
- Spending money for snacks, camp stores, and mission offering
- Summer clothing
- Wear your brightest neon colors for Mega Relay





WHAT NOT TO PACK:

- Alcohol, Illegal drugs, or vape
- Fireworks, water guns, or weapons
- Water balloons, shaving cream, silly string
- Family Pets
- Gaming devices
- Roller blades or skateboards
- Clothes that advertise alcohol, tobacco, drugs, sexual situations, racism, sexism, or hate
- Younger siblings
- Personal home gym





CAMP RULES

CELL PHONES

• Cell phone usage at camp will be allowed during the day. (Except during worship, activities, and bible studies.)

• Unless instructed by FUGE staff, students with cell phones are not allowed to have them out or in use during programming elements: Morning Celebration, Bible Study, Worship, Night Life, Recreation and Track Times/Ministry Tracks. Ringers should be turned to silent or vibrate.

ACTIVITIES

- Participate in all activities and be on time.
- Drink plenty of water and eat three meals a day.
- Wear closed-toe and closed-heel shoes to recreation and ministry sites.
- Wear your name tag at all times.
- Name calling, fighting, bullying, arguing, profanity or any other aggressive behaviors are strictly prohibited at camp. Play safely and use good sportsmanship.
- Always have a buddy. Don't go it alone.





CAMP RULES

HOUSING

- Be in your room by 11:00 PM with lights out no later than 11:30 PM.
- No guys in girls' rooms or hallways and no girls in guys' rooms or hallways.
- No public displays of affection.
- No practical jokes.
- Housing areas should be kept clean, in order, and free from damage.
- Valuables such as money, jewelry, and phones should be properly safeguarded.
- All campers are expected to respect the rights and property of others. Loud noise and similar intrusive behaviors are prohibited.
- Athletic activities such as running, playing, and throwing are prohibited in housing areas. These and similar activities are to be done outside.

WORSHIP

- No gum, food, or drinks allowed in the worship center.
- No video and flash photography is allowed in the worship center before or during the worship service.
- If campers must leave to go to the restroom, they should have an adult sponsor escort them. Make sure students go to the restroom before they go to worship.
